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# **Gozd Martuljek - Julian Alps, Slovenia** Saturday 2 - Saturday 9 July 2022

In the heart of the Julian Alps, just outside the Triglav National Park and near to the border triangle of Slovenia, Austria and Italy lies the idyllic alpine village of Kraniska Gora. In its immediate vicinity within the locality of Gozd Martuljek, and in front of one of the most beautiful backdrops of the Slovenian Alps, the Špik Group, is the newly constructed campsite Špik, where we will be guests for a week. The mountain scenery of the Spik group is unique. The north face of the Spik still «entices» classical alpinists and especially female alpinists, since in 1926 Mira Marko Debelak was the first to lead the Direct route, V+! The Julian Alps offer many V-VI degree routes in solid rock. To reach the majestic north face of Triglav you need only to drive to Mojstrana (8 km) and through the Vrata valley (13 km). The Mangart, which offers many classical «must do» routes as well as some bolted sport climbing routes, is also worth a visit. Possibilities for exploring the Julian Alps are numerous: hiking trails, Via Ferrata, MTB trails, water sports (kayaking, canoeing, canyoning, rafting) and also a bicycle route from Jesenice and Mojstrana via Kranjska Gora (5 km) to Tarvis (Italy). From Kranjska Gora you go over the Vršič-Pass (10 km) to reach the Trenta valley, which has several climbing options (also multi-pitch routes). For sport climbing, which is now most popular among RHM participants, Bohiniska Bela near Bled (30 km), Bohinj (60 km), as well as Blazceva skala above Mojstrana and the climbing area at Vršič-Pass deserve mention. Bathing in the beautiful Bled and Bohinj lakes offers an optional refreshing activity.

Why is the meeting taking place at the beginning of July? There are not so many tourists at this time (later the traffic on the road between Bled and Karavanke tunnel is really chaotic), and it will be relatively peaceful at camp sites, in the mountains and on the Vršič-Pass.

### Accommodation:

#### Camping Špik

The price per person and night (with a 10% discount) is  $\in$ 16.80 plus  $\in$ 1 local tax per day. Electricity is charged only once (for everyone together), namely 4.50  $\in$  per day. We have common use of a room with 40 seats, the "Bivak" bar and a covered terrace.

There is an artificial climbing wall on the edge of the campsite, and there are 2 sports climbing ladders within a 10-minute walk.

You can start directly from the campsite to the Martuljek or Špik group for climbing or hiking. The Mojstrana-Tarvisio cycling route is also very close to the campsite. <u>www.camp-spik.si</u>

#### **Restaurant and Pizzeria Jožica**

Just a 10-minute walk from the camp on the main street Ljubljana-Kranjska Gora is a good restaurant that offers excellent pizzas as well as meat and vegetarian dishes.

### **Getting there:**

#### By car

From Italy to Slovenia: via Fernetti/Fernetiči (via Ljubljana, Kranj and Jesenice), or Tarvisio/Rateče to Gozd Martuljek

From Austria: from Villach via Wurzenpass/Korensko sedlo or through the Karawanken tunnel, from Klagenfurt via Loiblpass/Ljubelj and Tržič to Jesenice, from Vienna via Spielfeld/Šentilj and Maribor to Ljubljana.

#### By bus

From Ljubljana via Kranj and Jesenice.

#### By train

The nearest train station is Jesenice (from Italy via Tarvisio, from Austria via Villach), and from there you can bus to Gozd Martuljek within half an hour.

From Italy-Trieste by train to Sežana and Ljubljana, or from Austria-Vienna by train to Maribor and Ljubljana, and thereafter by bus to Gozd Martuljek
